

Rooibos Champagne Cocktail

This is a **Scottish**¹ creation, using **Fair Trade** ingredients mainly from **South Africa**².

Quantities given make approximately 50 125 ml glasses of cocktail.

With thanks to **Equal Exchange**³ for the inspiration behind this recipe.

Ingredients

people, lemonade, in place of the champagne.

- 1 litre Fruit Passion **FAIRTRADE** orange juice
- 1 litre Fruit Passion **FAIRTRADE** apple juice
- 50 **FAIRTRADE** rooibos teabags
- 3 x 75 cl champagne bottles
- 30 g **FAIRTRADE** caster sugar
- 50 ice cubes

Method

Preparation

Use the 50 teabags to make 2 litres of Rooibos tea, allow to cool with the bags in.

Once cool, remove the bags and sweeten with the sugar.

Add the orange juice and the apple juice.

Add the ice cubes.

To serve

Pour 75 ml (approx) into each flute and top up with the champagne.

Variations

For people unable to drink alcohol, substitute sparkling mineral water, or for sweet toothed
